

Booth Reservations

To reserve your booth space(s) today click on **reserve now button** on the upper right hand corner of this page.

To help make the booth selection simple, we use MapDynamics. This software system helps you reserve your desired booth location in real-time. To reserve a booth space, a non-refundable deposit of \$250 per booth is required. You can choose to pay in full but if not, the remaining portion of your booth fee will be sent out as an invoice via email due by June 28. Booths will not be allowed to open unless full payment has been made. If you do not pay in full by June 28 your booth may be resold.

Every effort is made to accommodate exhibitor preferences as availability of exhibit space permits. AIA Iowa reserves the right to modify the floor plan and reassign booth space in the best interest of the convention.

Booth Staff

Tickets for two exhibitor staff to attend the convention and tickets for two lunches come with each booth purchased. A limited number of additional tickets will be available for purchase online during the booth registration, process the tickets will be first come, first served due to capacity limits.

Early Bird Discount

Save by reserving your booth(s) before **June 12**, after this date the regular booth rate applies. Booth Types

Regular Booths are located in the Exhibit Hall and measure 8' deep x 10' wide numbered 17-41, 44-57, 60-72, 75-98, 101-113, 116-129, and 132-156. Each booth has an 8' high black back drapery and 3' high black side draperies.

Premium Booths are located in the high traffic areas and get the most exposure. They can be found in both the Mezzanine where you will find the registration desk and multiple special exhibits, and in the Exhibit Hall near the main entrance and by lounge areas.

Premium Booths on the Mezzanine are 10' x 10' spaces numbered 1-16. These are the first booths seen by attendees when walking to and from the registration desk and special exhibits. As a bonus, a special drink station will be set-up during the Cocktail Party in the middle of this area. Booths against walls will have an 8' high black back drapery and 3' high black side draperies. Booths (3-8) will have only 3' high black side draperies with open front and back entrances.

Premium Booths in the Exhibit Hall are 8' x10' spaces numbered 42, 43, 58, 59, 73, 74, 99, 100, 114, 115, 130, and 131. They are either the first thing attendees see when they walk in the hall or are next to a designated lounge area. Each booth has an 8' high black back drapery and 3' high black side draperies.

Booth cost includes a standard identification sign provided by Freeman that will read the company

name provided to AIA Iowa when you reserve your booth space(s). The entire Exhibit Hall and Mezzanine is carpeted.

Cancellation & Refunds

Requests for cancellation, either full or partial, must be made in writing and sent either by registered or certified mail. No refunds will be made to requests postmarked on or after **June 28**. No refund may be made for space that is unused during all or part of the exhibition. Should space remain unoccupied at the opening of the exhibit, AIA Iowa may rent or use it without obligation of a refund. No refunds of booth deposits will be given if AIA Iowa deems it necessary to adapt the event format for the safety of attendees. By signing up as an exhibitor you agree to adhere to AIA Iowa's rules and regulations for this year's event.

Liability

It is expressly understood and agreed by the signing of the contract that the exhibitor assumes the entire responsibility and liability for losses, damages and claims arising out of the injury or damage to an exhibitor's display, equipment and other property brought onto the premises of the Iowa Events Center, and shall hold harmless AIA Iowa, and the Iowa Events Center, as well as their agents, servants and employees from any and all such losses, damages and claims.

Exhibitor Packets

Exhibitors' information packets may be picked up at the registration desk Sunday, **September 22** during booth set-up. Many items are in this packet including: Exhibitor nametags and lunch tickets, any additional tickets purchased, a list of convention registrants and a map of the exhibit hall. Exhibitors are required to submit in advance the names of staff members who will be working in the booths. Exhibitors are asked to wear their name badges during all Convention functions.

Furnishings

Booth furnishings and equipment are the responsibility of the exhibitor. Exhibitors may bring in their own tables, chairs, etc. if they are in compliance with Iowa Events Center regulations.

Six-foot black skirted tables and standard chairs will be available to rent at a discounted group rate with AIA Iowa when reserving your booth(s). Furnishings at the group rate can be ordered through AIA Iowa until **August 19.**

Electricity & Wi-Fi

Electrical services are managed by the Iowa Events Center but will be sold in advance through AIA Iowa when reserving your booth(s). Connections cover only the connecting of electrical services to the booth in the most convenient manner and do not include connecting equipment or special wiring. All electrical connections must be made by the Iowa Events Center electrician, building wall and post outlets are not part of booth space and are not to be used by the exhibitors per Iowa Events Center. Electricity ordered on-site may be subject to a surcharge. Complimentary Wi-Fi will be available in the exhibit hall.

Set-Up & Tear-down

Booths must be set up from 12:00 Noon-8:00 p.m., Sunday, **September 22**, at the Iowa Events Center, Des Moines, Iowa. All exhibits must be set up by 7:00 a.m., Monday, **September 23**. Exhibits may be taken down beginning at 11:30 a.m., Tuesday, **September 24**. The loading dock doors located at the northeast corner of the building will open at 11:30 a.m. Exhibits must not be dismantled before tear-down, 11:30 a.m., Tuesday, September 24. All displays must be removed from the Exhibit Hall by no later than 4:00 p.m. Tuesday, September 24.

Meals & Refreshments

Lunch on Monday, **September 23**, from 11:45 a.m.-1:15 p.m. will be a sit-down event for both exhibitors and convention registrants. Two complimentary tickets are included per booth and may be requested in the AIA Iowa Map Dynamics software during the registration process, you must indicate that you would like the two complimentary tickets to receive them. A limited number of extra exhibitor passes, and lunch tickets can be purchased through the booth reservation process, first come-first served. Breakfasts and refreshments will be served in the Exhibit Hall per the schedule provided. Cocktail party refreshments will be provided in the Mezzanine and Exhibit Hall.

Cocktail Party

The Cocktail Party will be held Monday, **September 23**, from 5:00-6:30 p.m. in the Mezzanine and Exhibit Hall areas. Convention registrants and exhibitors will join for beverages, snacks, and door prizes while convention registrants visit your booth(s). You can use your pre-purchased drink tickets during this event & exhibitor provided door prizes (that's you!) will be given out during this time.

Music

Because of aggressive enforcement laws related to copyrighted music, we must ask our exhibitors either: 1) not to play live or recorded music that is subject to licensing by BMI, ASCAP or any other organization authorized to license copyrighted music; or 2) to obtain for themselves, at their sole expense, the proper license from the copyright holder. If an exhibitor plays music that is subject to licensing and AIA Iowa is obligated to pay any copyright holder, all costs of the copyright license, and the incidental costs in conjunction with the license, shall be paid by the exhibitor as an additional booth charge.
