



Terms and Conditions for Vendors 2018 – Environmental Services

ALL vendors participating in MuslimFest 2016 are subject to the following stipulations stated below. Failure to comply may result in discretionary action by either:

1. MuslimFest
2. The City of Mississauga

As part of the Green initiative with the City of Mississauga, all Vendors are strictly prohibited from bringing plastic water bottles for sale during the event.



Vendors are strictly prohibited from disposing waste in the form of grease into the sink located behind the marketing trellis

- i. A grease barrel will be provided to food vendors in order to dispose of waste properly, as the sink is strictly for dumping water or water-like fluids
- ii. Vendors **MUST** dispose of grease only in their assigned grease barrels

Extra garbage and recycling bins will be provided to vendors

- i. Vendors are responsible for ensuring that any waste produced is correctly sorted into the appropriate waste bins provided (ie. Garbage, recycling, waste)
- ii. Ensure that all waste with the exception of liquids and cardboard boxes are bagged as appropriate
- iii. Please note that MuslimFest **DOES NOT** charge food vendors or track the waste produced at the event and fine accordingly
 - a. ***Fines issued to vendors are directly associated to the charges issued to MuslimFest by the City of Mississauga***
 - b. ***In the case that a vendor damages any apparatus belonging to the aforementioned parties, where MuslimFest is billed or fined for, the offending vendor will have that exact amount deducted from their damage deposit as a fine***

In order to transport waste to the garbage and/or recycling bins, a trolley will be made available

1. Two trolleys will be provided by the City of Mississauga in total:
 - i. ***One trolley for garbage***

- ii. One trolley for recycling**
 - iii. Vendors will be charged by the City of Mississauga for any damage to the trolleys**
2. Trolleys are reserved for situations in which both the waste disposal company and the vendors are unable to properly dispose of their waste (ie. Rush hour)
- i. The Environmental Services Team is only responsible for vendor waste disposal in the case that such instances arise during the festival**

In the case of an event in which vendors must dispose of broken materials, Environmental Services reserves the right to:

- 1. Personally dispose of the mess in a safe manner
- 2. Await the arrival of the waste disposal company, who will arrive and handle the situation
